ORDER


THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff's Notice Regarding Status of Service on Defendants ("Notice," Doc. 17). On April 21, 2021, this Court entered a Temporary Restraining Order ("TRO," Doc. 6) against all Defendants and scheduled a preliminary injunction hearing on April 29, 2021. (*Id.* at 5–6). The TRO ordered Plaintiff to serve a copy of the TRO on Defendants and file proof of service. (*Id.* at 5). In the Notice, Plaintiff advises the Court that it has been unable to serve

Defendant Jonathan P. Maroney because he is currently in Honduras.¹ (Doc. 17 at 3). In light of this information, the Court will extend the TRO and reschedule the preliminary injunction hearing in order to ensure that Maroney has an opportunity to attend the hearing.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

- 1. The TRO is extended through and including May 7, 2021, unless dissolved or extended for good cause by this Court.**
- 2. The preliminary injunction hearing is rescheduled to May 6, 2021, at 2:00 PM.² Defendants are on notice that failure to appear at the hearing may result in the imposition of a preliminary injunction without further notice.**
3. Plaintiff shall continue its attempts to notify Defendant Jonathan P. Maroney of the TRO. Additionally, Plaintiff shall provide a copy of this Order to all Defendants.³
