
ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Receiver's Unopposed Seventh Quarterly Fee Application (Doc. 168). The United States Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation (Doc. 171), recommending that the Motion be granted. (*Id.* at 1, 6).

After review in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72, and noting that no objections were timely filed, the Magistrate Judge's recommended disposition is accepted. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Report and Recommendation (Doc. 171) is **ADOPTED** and made a part of this Order.
2. Receiver's Unopposed Seventh Quarterly Fee Application (Doc. 168) is **GRANTED**.
 - a. Receiver shall be paid \$9,975.00 in fees.
 - b. Receiver is permitted to pay the law firm Johnson, Newlon & DeCort, P.A. \$8,155.00 in fees and \$5,778.83 for expenses.
