
ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Receiver's Unopposed Eighth Quarterly Fee Application (Doc. 174). The United States Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation (Doc. 175), recommending that the Motion be granted. (*Id.* at 1, 6).
